Baptist World Cult Evangelism


In the Bible Belt of America, Jehovah's Witnesses and Mormons boast that over 50 percent of their converts are Ex-Baptists. Not being able to answer questions like these is the main reason:

- 1. Did Jesus have a God? (John 20:17)
- 2. Was Jesus the first-born (meaning to a JW He was created) of every creature? (Col 1:15)
- 3. Is the Father the only true God? (John 17:3)

When these questions were asked of professing Christians, regardless of whether they had no Bible training, some Bible training (informal), a four-year degree, a master's degree, or a PhD, the results were the same. Ninety-nine percent of them could not answer all three questions correctly.

Teaching Christians at all levels how to answer critical questions about the person of Jesus Christ—without proof-texting or going outside the context of the verse—can be accomplished by learning and applying a few basic hermeneutical principles.
