points of the love doctrine in 1
Corinthians 13.

WHAT DOES CHARITY DO? 1 Cor 13:4-8

1. It suffers long
2. It is kind
3. It envies not (not jealous)
4. It vaunts not itself (it doesn't brag about itself)
5. It is not puffed up (not arrogant)
6. It does not behave itself unseemly (rudely)
7. It seeks not her own (not self centered)
8. It is not easily provoked (not touchy)
9. It thinks no evil (keeps no account of evil)
10. It rejoices not in iniquity
11. It rejoices in truth
12. It bears all things
13. It believes all things
14. It hopes in all things
15. It endures in all things
16. It never fails

Conclusion:

1Cor 14:1 **Follow after charity**, and desire spiritual gifts, but rather that ye may prophesy.

To follow after charity means to make it a lifelong pursuit and seek to acquire it. If you memorize these 16 points and begin to put them into practice, your life will change. Start today! Those who reach this step of Christian maturity will have the greatest joy and reward at the judgment seat of Christ.

2. Gift of prophecy and have not charity, I am nothing.
3. Gift of understanding all mysteries and have not charity, I am nothing.
4. Gift of all knowledge and have not charity, I am nothing.
5. Gift of all faith and have not charity, I am nothing.
6. Give all my goods to feed the poor and have not charity, I am nothing.
7. Give my body to be burned and have not charity, it profits me nothing.
